Employment Details & Job Description

We are offering a paid internship initially from September 2016 until July 2017. We will pay £7.20 per hour for 20 hours a week at but it should be noted that these hours will be irregular.

Obviously you will be expected to take a full part in the life of Credo as all our members do, including attendance at Tuesday evening community nights, planning and rehearsals, and a variety of performances (acting and all aspects of stage management) which can of course take place on different days and times (including weekends)

In addition to this, you will:

- Help plan and run our weekly youth drama club, Amo, currently meeting on a Thursday early evening, drawing young people from across the city to have fun and explore drama together
- Work with at least 3 local churches/groups to help them devise and run a creative activity and/or performance as part of the Believe in Hull – Communities of Culture initiative, which in turn is part of Hull's exciting plans for City of Culture 2017
- Take part in schools work in the run up to Communities of Culture's flagship event – Feed the 5,000 in June 2017
- Take on administrative tasks for Credo, including internal communications, publicity, bookings, and updating our database
- Attend meetings, particularly in relation to City of Culture, on behalf of Credo and act as an appropriate ambassador for us
- Carry out occasional caretaking and cleaning tasks around our rehearsal and office space

But also:

We want this to be a year in which you can develop your own particular interests, so we are very interested in giving you the time and opportunities to do this, and are connected with other creatives across the city to enable this to happen.
